

Lunches to Go

Please make 35 lunches



Each bag should include:

- A small can of Vienna sausages, pork and beans, deviled ham or chicken, or a tuna pouch; the cans must have a pop-up tab (please include a plastic fork)
- Snack-size containers of snack foods such as raisins, dried fruit, crackers, cheese and cracker snack packs, chewy or granola bar
- Small bag of chips or pretzels
- Fruit (apple/orange/fruit cup)
- 1 or 2 cookies, brownie, etc.
- A small bottled water or juice box

Delivery:

Please deliver the lunches in a container marked “EOS Lunches to Go” by 7pm. From 9am until 5pm Monday through Friday, you may bring the lunches through the side gate to the back door of the kitchen. After 5 pm and on weekends, please bring them to our front lobby.

The lunches will be distributed to the women and children who have stayed in our Emergency Overnight Shelter as they leave in the morning.
