

## Creating a Christian Preamble for Your Will

Jesus calls us to bear witness to the salvation made possible through His death and resurrection.

When planning your Will, you can grow so preoccupied with how to distribute your material blessings that you may fail to share your true wealth, your last testimony: **the Good News of forgiveness of sin and eternal life through faith in Jesus Christ.**

A Christian Preamble is your personal statement of your faith, which serves to comfort your loved ones in their time of loss and encourages them to place their trust in Jesus Christ.

When you meet with your attorney, request that your preamble be included in your Will and placed at the very beginning.

Here is a sample Christian Preamble:

*I commit myself to God's care, secure in His love for me, knowing that I'll spend eternity with Him, and trusting in the salvation provided for me through Christ's death and resurrection. To those who survive me, please take comfort knowing I am now with the Lord in joy, love and eternal glory.*

*To my loved ones, I commend you to the protecting arm of God, knowing He will continue to provide for you despite my absence. Please place your life and trust in Him alone.*

Bring assurance and peace to your loved ones and provide a final testimony to Christ's salvation through a Christian Preamble. May His peace and wisdom be always with you.
