



Reith had a rough start to life. His family was involved in illegal activities, and Keith grew up surrounded by drugs and alcohol. When he got older, he was pulled into dangerous situations that led to incarceration. When he was released, Keith moved back in with his family – but he soon realized that was a mistake.

"When I came home my family was trying to get me to do things that would have sent me back to prison. They were trying to force me to sell drugs and go about life the wrong way – but I wanted to do things different, because I knew where I would end up the other way."

The problem was that without his family, Keith had nowhere to go – so he became homeless. He lived on the streets for several weeks before he reached out to a helpline and was referred to the Mission.

Today, Keith is in one of the last stages of our recovery program. He has a job and a car, and he hopes to buy his own home in

the future. He has been attending church regularly and was baptized.

"God put people in my life who have been game changers for me. I knew in my heart I wanted to change, but I couldn't do it alone – until the Mission helped me. Now I just want to be the best son I can be for the Lord."

Thanks to the Mission, I know I'm a blessed child of God.

You help give New Life!

Thank you for changing lives through the New Life Plan.



The New Life Plan is our answer to addiction, homelessness and other chronic challenges in our community. It is a long-term recovery program that first addresses the immediate needs of our clients – food, clothing, hygiene and healthcare - before offering counseling, classes and vocational training aimed at self-sufficiency.

The services provided as part of our New Life Plan are extensive and financially significant. We're able to offer them only through the generosity of friends like you.



New client set up - When someone enrolls in the New Life Plan, they receive items like clothing, shoes, hygiene products and linens to make them feel comfortable and at home.

Average cost for initial needs: \$200 per person



Instructional materials - Raleigh Rescue Mission provides books, stationery, Bibles and other resources and instructional materials for all clients enrolled in our weekly classes.

Average cost for materials: \$1,000 per month



Professional clothing for Jobs for Life - Phase 3 clients who start our Jobs for Life class receive three to five work-appropriate outfits, including dress shirts/blouses, dress slacks, blazers, suits, skirts/dresses and dress shoes.

Average cost for professional clothing: \$3,000 per month



Life preparation – Clients also receive assistance securing a career-focused job and finding an affordable apartment. We provide 25% of the cost of a reliable used car, so they can purchase a vehicle and still be debt free. They also receive

financial coaching and/or counseling to prepare them to live independently after leaving the Mission. Our aim is to equip them to thrive without government assistance.

You can help empower a neighbor to be successful in their second chance at a New Life. Consider how you can make a difference through essential needs, instructional materials, professional clothing, life-preparation education and more.
